HOSPITAL MEMORANDUM

No. 423, s. 2024

TO : ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : Non-Wearing of DOH-Prescribed Uniform on October 31, 2024

In view of the shortened working hours of back offices on October 31, 2024 pursuant to Hospital Memorandum No. 422, s. 2024, and in relation to Memorandum Circular No. 67, all SPMC back office personnel are hereby exempted from wearing the DOH-prescribed uniform on October 31, 2024 (Thursday).

However, it is reiterated that appropriate business attire, and the official SPMC Identification Card (ID) must be worn at all times while on duty.

The following are considered inappropriate and prohibited attire as per CSC Memorandum Circular No. 19, s. 2000 / CSC Resolution No. 002515 dated October 31, 2000.

- Gauzy, transparent or net-like shirt or blouse;
- Sando, strapless or spaghetti-strap blouse (unless worn as an underskirt), tank-tops, blouse with over-plunging necklines;
- Micro-mini skirt, walking shorts, cycling shorts, leggings, tights, jogging pants;
- Rubber sandals, rubber slippers, “bakya”

Please be guided accordingly.
